As first chair of the Multi Faith Network I guided it in developing its remit, and delivered three events as well, including the Diversity Impact Assessment Awareness event at Westwood (which I still get enquiries about) in 2016. I helped develop the Ethos for the network in particular the integrated approach where we have all faiths represented as far as possible rather than single faith groups. I also oversaw the delivery of the enhanced and expanded Multi Faith Room at MK and the development of a vision for facilities at all NR offices.

In Inspire I have helped us work with the other Networks and share expertise, in particular in developing a Mentoring Coaching Scheme, the pilot of which is about to roll out in Western Route.

I have also been part of the leadership team for delivering and developing the Allies Programme for Inspire as remitted by Mark Carne.

I have been part of the TU/NR Equalities Working Group since 2012, at the very inception of D & I in the company, and have given talks to outside bodies to highlight the development of D & I in NR.
